12. All-in-one daysuit (x1), size 3-6 months

16. Fleece jacket with hood (x1), size 3-6 months



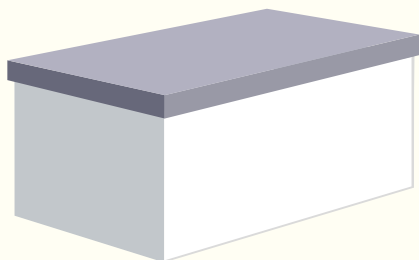

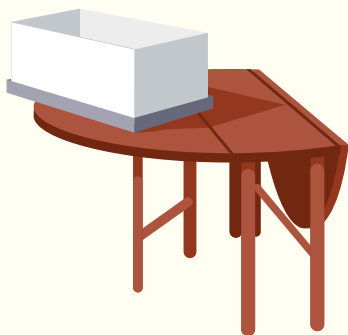

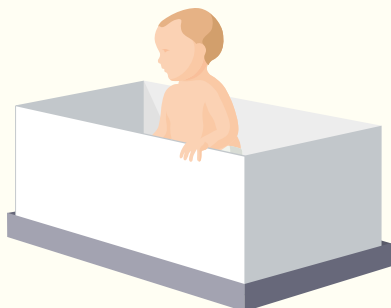
Things to remember when using the box for your baby to sleep in



1. The lid should not go on the box when your baby is in it, but should be used as a base by placing it underneath.



2. Don't be tempted to place the box on a table or surface in case it falls. Keep the box flat and don't prop it up.



3. The box is suitable as a sleeping space for young babies. When your child can kneel or pull themselves up, the Baby Box should no longer be used for sleeping.



4. Put the Baby Box on the floor or in the cot (sitting inside the lid).



5. Only use the mattress provided with the box.



6. If you need to move the Baby Box, lift your baby out first, remembering to bend at the knees.



7. Keep the Baby Box close to you when your baby is sleeping in it. This will help them to feel secure.
